The Circular Future

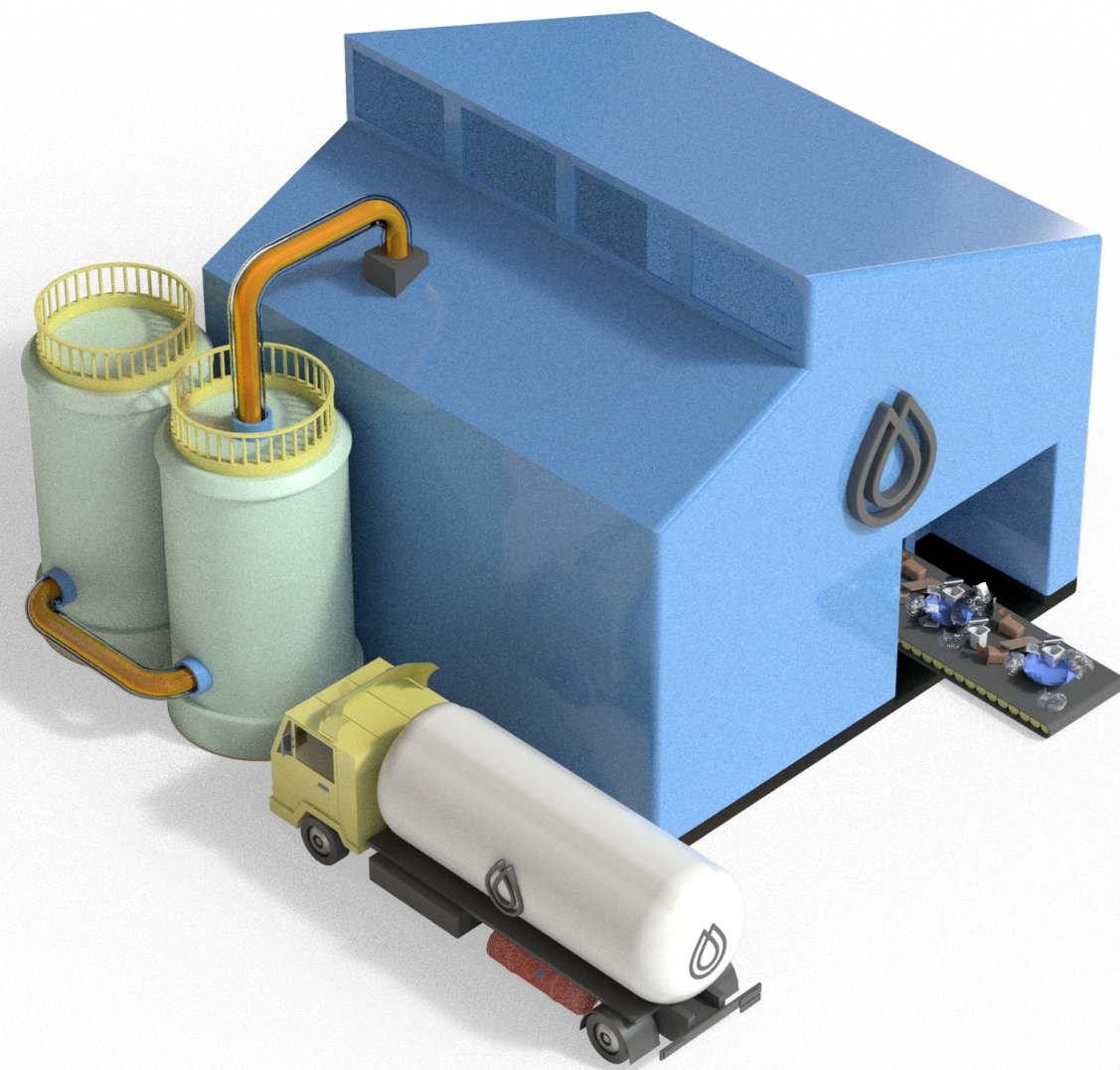
(By 2025)

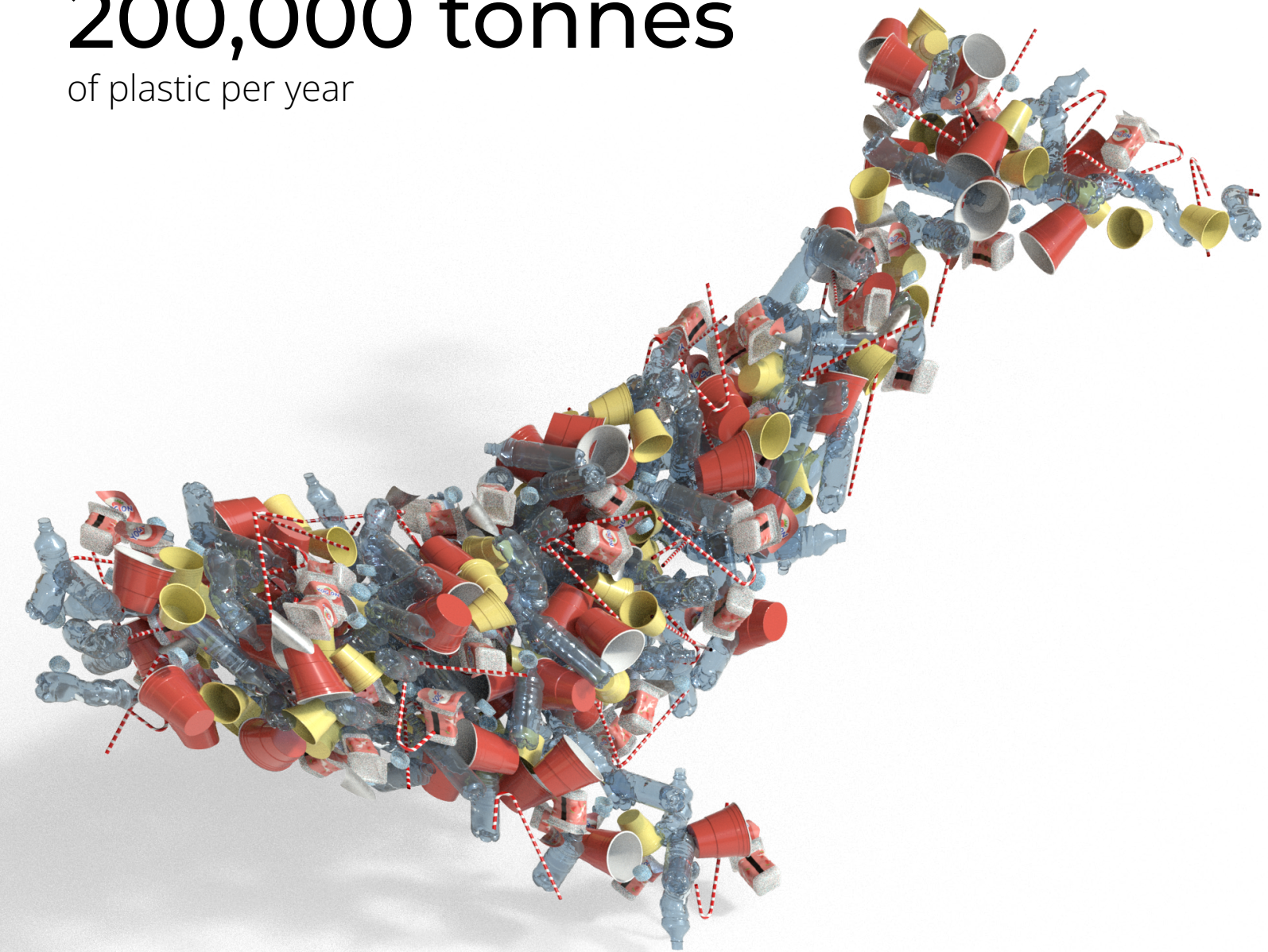
